## 2010 DOG SHOW-Rules and Regulation

- Any 4-H member enrolled in the Dog project or the Exploring 4-H project eligible.
- A member may show a dog owned by another person, provided the member has trained and worked with that animal for at least 90 days prior to the county dog show.
- A 4-H member shall determine his own lot for showing. However a member may not show the same dog in a lower obedience lot number than what he has previously shown nor one that he has received a purple ribbon at the State Fair. (The exception being the Open Class, Brace and Team lot numbers.) However, he may use a different dog. This applies to both Juniors and Seniors.
- Two members may not show the same dog.
- All dogs, regardless of age or breed, are eligible to show.
- All breeds of dogs show together.
- In a 4-H Dog Show, breed, color and conformation of the dog will not be considered.
- No female dogs in estrus may be shown.
- \*Dogs must be annually immunized against distemper, parainfluenza, leptospirosis, rabies, hepatitis, and parvo. A corona virus shot is also recommended.
- Dogs must have been free of an infectious illness for 30 days before the show.
- **A health certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian must be made available prior to the show.**
- You are recommended to have a 6 ft. leather or nylon leash with a snap bolt on one end and a loop on the other end.
- A close fitting choke collar is required. Fancy or spiked collars are not allowed.
- Lots may be divided into groups at the discretion of the judge.
- Exhibitors are to be clean, well groomed and must wear shoes (no sandals or open toed shoes). No advertising will be allowed.
