Lincoln County 4-H Achievement Days August 2-5

Lincoln County 4-H Achievement Days is soon upon us as July gives way to August, South Dakota's traditional fair month.

Monday August 2nd is entry day. 4-H exhibits will be entered from 6 - 9 p.m. There will be some added attractions at this year's event. They include food vendors, added educational displays, a climbing wall, and dunk tank. Achievement Days is free and open to the public.

Open Class exhibits will be entered in the west Quonset from 5 - 7 p.m. on Monday August 2nd. In addition, they will host their annual "Heritage Day" on Wednesday August 4th. This year's theme is "The Old West." Entry of western heritage exhibits will be taken for display from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. Public display is scheduled between 1 - 9 p.m.

A reminder to 4-H groups and public notice that there will be no parking of vehicles south of the buildings. This is in order to create more space for displays, vendors, and a safer area for pedestrians.

The 4-H barbeque will once again feature traditional pork loin sandwiches prepared by the Lincoln County Pork Producers. Barbecue tickets are available to purchase at the Extension Office and will also be available at the fairgrounds August 3 and 4th.
