

These minutes have not been approved.

The Lincoln County 4-H leaders meeting was held June 22, 2009 at 7:00 PM. The meeting was called in order. The minutes of the last meeting were approved. There was not a treasurer's report read at this time but the balance was e-mailed to the secretary. The balance in the checking account stands at \$4900.19 and the balance on the CD is \$3075.13.

Old Business

Three clubs still need to get the IRS e filing in. It was noted that we can get a fine for not filing.

The State Leaders Association returned \$500. They received \$2000 from the National 4-H. Monsanto gave the conferences money. It was also noted that the State Association was moving the meetings to the fall. The date selected was November 13, 2009. It will be held in either Huron or Mitchell.

The Recognition Event will be in Canton and it will be a potluck. Ross was absent and he was the one that knew the date. We will find the date and share it through the newsletter.

New Business

We need someone to cater the premium sale meal. It averages about 70 people. Marc Bogue will check with Fiesta about catering the meal. Marcia will ask Scott about the pork producers.

We discussed t-shirts for the county fair. The Jensen's have secured \$1000 but the total needed is \$1250. It was decided to use the returned money for the t-shirts. Each club needs to get the sizes of each of their club members to the office by pre-registration.

Camp Bob Marshall was the next item of discussion. The amount of fuel used last year was \$493. It should be less this year. It was decided we would pay for the gas for the trip out there and back.

The State Fair project exhibit drop-off will be August 19 and 20 from 3:00-6:30. The exhibits will need to be taken to the old Extension office. The non-perishable items can be dropped off the morning of September 1. It will be signed in as usual.

Marcia discussed the National Conference which will be held in Lincoln, Nebraska. She encouraged us to go. She stated that we have to have 20 in attendance to keep this going. I did not have a date noted for this event.

The event at Newton Hills was reviewed. It will be July 14-15. You have to be 4-H age to attend. It will start at 4:00 on the 14th and finish at 11:00 the next morning.

There was a reminder of pre-registration day which will be on July 16. The judging school date has been changed from June 25-to June 30. It was noted that volunteers were still needed for the 4-H horse show. They need people to serve food. It was also noted that we have adequate judges for Achievement Days.

The date for the September meeting was set for the 28th. It will start at 7:00 PM. The Lincoln Blinkers will be bringing cake.

The meeting was adjourned.
