It was decided that the static exhibits will be released at 6:30pm on Thursday night of the fair. No species of animals will be released until after the premium sale and their pens have been cleaned and it has been cleared by a committee member.

Dorothy Nothdrift (open class) is interested in sponsoring the Swanson Family event in the horse arena at 2:00. The date was not specifically stated. If they (open class) do this, they will organize and pay for it.

There was discussion concerning the parking at the fairgrounds. It was decided due to safety issues that there will be no parking on the south road beginning at Tuesday 10:00am – Thursday 6:30pm. Parking will be from the Quonset and west. An achievement day activity committee was formed. The members of this committee are Ross Lothrop, Wendy Lawrenson, Kevin Jensen, Karen Kaske and Daneen Gannon. They will bring guidelines to the June meeting for discussion .

A preference sheet for the make-it take-it project day was discussed.
