

## UNAPPROVED

The Lincoln County 4-H Leaders meeting was called to order at 6:40 by Rhonda Dinan. The flag pledges were said. The minutes of the last meeting were available for the group in written form and were reviewed. There being no corrections or additions, the minutes were approved as written. The treasurer's report was given, checks dating as far back as 1999 have not cleared the account, so the new treasurer started with a new account in the computer program. This will make it easier for balancing and reconciling.

Old Business: clubs need to get the 2010 secretaries books and the audits of the treasures accounts to the Extension office. These need to be turned in to complete the 4-H year that ended in September of 2010.

Clubs were to bring feedback to the leaders meeting of the interest in Adam Wirt's Lamb Enhancement program. Currently there is only one member interested in the program. Scott Hyronimus gave a report of the State 4-H Leaders Conference held in Rapid City over the weekend. There were 80+ adults with 23 INB kids attending. Those leaders attending the workshops thought they were very worthwhile and the INB kids enjoyed the activities. Dean Dunn addressed the leaders about the current financial status of the college and the Cooperative Extension Service. Adam Lambert addressed the leaders about the need for hosts for the LABO programs and other exchange programs.

It was noted the officers for the current year were not nominated and voted upon. Lola T made the motion to keep the current slate of officers for the Leaders Association, Mary DeVany seconded, all ayes. Mary also volunteered to be a 1<sup>st</sup> year director.

The date for the recognition event has not been discussed by the clubs involved. The location will be Lennox. The clubs will contact the Extension office with the date when they have met and decided.

There was not a report from the Achievement Days enhancement committee, no members were present.

The sponsor for the 4-H T shirts was not present, the thought was to try to get the shirts done before the next leaders meeting in June and distribute them at that time.

Clubs need to file the e-file card BEFORE the May 15 deadline. This will be for the 2010 year. Fruit sort day is April 7, 8:30 AM at the Sunshine Foods store in Canton. Some of the usual customers for the fruit sale expressed disappointment almost every choice had pears. People also expressed disappointment with the lack of any grapefruit availability in the selections. Clubs are reminded to get the insurance and preference sheets to the office by April 15.

A FYI from Lola T, Jordan Jensen has received a scholarship from a school in Tennessee for Shooting. What an honor for a 4-Her.

The next 4-H Leaders meeting will be June 20, 7:00pm at the Courthouse.
