The Lincoln County Commission convened in a Special joint session with the Sioux Falls City Council at 7:00 P.M., January 23, 2006, at the Lincoln County Courthouse, Canton, South Dakota.

Commissioners present were: Dennis Weeldreyer, Burdell Coplan, Michael Poppens, Otto Hagedorn, and Jim Schmidt. The County Auditor was Clerk of the Board.

City Council members present were: Darrin Smith, Kevin Kavanaugh, Bob Jamison, De Knudson, Vernon Brown, Kermit L. Staggers, and Andy Howes. Absent: Council Member Gerald Beninga and Mayor Dave Munson.

Lincoln County Commission Chairman, Dennis Weeldreyer, called the meeting to order.

The meeting was led with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Mayor Munson arrived at 7:03 p.m.

The second reading was held on an Ordinance of Lincoln County, SD, adopting the 2006 Joint Zoning regulations for Lincoln County and the City of Sioux Falls.

RESOLUTION: WHEREAS, Lincoln County has published "Notice of Hearing" and has held a Hearing and first and second readings of an Ordinance adopting the 2006 Joint Zoning Regulations for Lincoln County and the City of Sioux Falls NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY LINCOLN COUNTY, SD, That the 2006 Joint Zoning Regulations for Lincoln County and the City of Sioux Falls are hereby adopted The 2006 Joint Zoning Regulations and associated Official Zoning Map are on file with the Lincoln County Auditor and the Sioux Falls City Clerk. Motion by Schmidt and seconded by Coplan. All Commissioners voted "Aye".

The Sioux Falls City Council concurred with six members voting "Aye" and one member voting "Nay".

RESOLUTION: BE IT RESOLVED BY LINCOLN COUNTY, SD: WHEREAS, Lincoln County and the City of Sioux Falls have agreed upon a boundary for a joint jurisdictional area; and WHEREAS, Lincoln County and the City of Sioux Falls have adopted by ordinance joint zoning regulations that apply in the joint jurisdictional area; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY LINCOLN COUNTY, SD: That it approves the Joint Lincoln County/City of Sioux Falls Planning Commission Bylaws that are on file with the Lincoln County Auditor and the Sioux Falls City Clerk. Motion by Schmidt and seconded by Coplan. All Commissioners voted "Aye".

The Sioux Falls City Council concurred with six members voting "Aye" and one member voting "Nay".

Motion by Hagedorn and seconded by Coplan to adjourn. Motion carried.
