The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners met at 7:00 pm July 10, 2007 with members Burdell Coplan, Jim Schmidt, Otto Hagedorn, Dennis Weeldreyer and Dale Long present. The Auditor was Clerk of the Board. The meeting was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Burdell Coplan opened the meeting with introductions. The purpose of the meeting was to address the adverse secondary effects of sexually oriented businesses.

Manny Steele, State Representative, District 12, encouraged the county to look at an ordinance to stop sexually oriented businesses from opening.

Sandy Jerstad, State Senator, District 12, stated that she would work to pass legislation to mandate counties to pass zoning restrictions to prevent sexually oriented businesses from opening.

Several other people gave testimony addressing the adverse secondary effects of sexually oriented businesses and encouraged the county commissioners to act on getting regulations in place.

Jim Schmidt closed the meeting stating that it will take the cooperation of municipalities, counties and the state to accomplish restricting this type of business.

Motion by Schmidt and seconded by Hagedorn to adjourn.

The Board adjourned until 8:30 am July 24, 2007.
