The Lincoln County Drainage Board convened at 11:00 a.m. on November 4, 2010 with David Gillespie, Jason Melcher, Dennis Weeldreyer and Dale Long present. Jim Schmidt was absent. The Auditor was Clerk of the Board.

Don Hoffman addressed the Board concerning culverts washed out on Nine Mile Creek and the flooding of his property causing thousands of dollars of loss to his crops.

Louella DeJong presented rainfall figures and photos taken of flooding on her property. There was discussion of the drainage responsibility of cities due to the increase of development within the city limits.

Russ Crawford expressed concerns about the water coming from the Blue Spruce Addition and from the City of Tea.

Jon Peters, Lincoln County GIS Department, was present to address the possibility of the County adopting a Drainage Plan and Drainage Ordinance.

Motion by Gillespie and seconded by Melcher to adjourn as the Drainage Board. Motion carried.
