

Welcome to our online Lincoln County GIS Web Application!

To access the GIS Interactive Map, enter gis.lincolncountysd.org/public into the address bar of Internet Explorer or your favorite browser. You will be prompted for your username and password if you are a county employee to access the map.

On the top banner is a link to the GIS home page. Here you can find our current county reference maps, printable at 8" x 11". Also available here are links to other pertinent websites, the towns within our county and a floodplain information page. A link to the Sioux Falls and Minnehaha GIS map sites is also provided.

The tool bar at the top just below the banner contains the buttons to query, maneuver and interact with the map.

To query, just click on the type of search you wish to start and enter the information you have, and select Find. Follow the windows and drop down arrows to show the information you are looking for. By right clicking you can select to pan or zoom to your selected location in the map.

The commands to the right require you to select the button in order to enable the function in the map. Examples: Click the zoom button(+), hold the left mouse button and drag a box over the area of the map you wish to zoom to. Click the Pan button (hand), then hold the left mouse button while moving it the direction you want the map to move. Click the identify (i) button, then click on the parcel you want the information for. The measure button measures length and area with options to show meters, feet, miles, acres and sq. miles.

Map Layers are located to the left of the map frame. Individual layers are turned on and off by the checkbox preceding them. Several groups of additional layers are available by expanding the + option preceding the category.

Take some time to go through each command to become familiar with finding the things you want when you need to.
